Pachypodium rutenbergianum Vatke

Vontaky

Small spiny tree with little branching found here and there along the drier parts of the Canoco trail.

Striking features

- spiny trunk
- terminal upright pods
- tufts of densee long green leaves at apex of shoots



Description

Stature: branching occurs after flowering. And is absent in juveniles. Size: shrub to small tree (to 8 m). Bark: extremely prickly.

Leaves: new flush of leaves occur at the apex of shoots.

Flower: large showy white flowers..

Ecology


Status and distribution: Found along the NW of Madagascar. Kirindy is about its southern limit.

Habitat requirements: This species is usually found in drier regions than Kirindy, thus here it occurs in the driest habitats.

Phenology: deciduous, new flush of growth in Nov-Dec. Inflorescences appear at the same time as leaves. *Kirindy*: uncommon. Can be found here and there along the Canoco trail.

Reproduction: One leafless tree had pods in November 2008.
